Our children were not able to go out during the long winter. The children enjoy being outside and it is good for them to be outdoors. I know they are excited to be outside playing and enjoying the better weather.

Many volunteers have told us that the attitude of our caregivers has changed a lot and they have noticed progress with many of the children. Some of them are walking with agate trainers, smiling and listening to our activities.



The caregivers are participating in skits, singing, and telling stories to the children. Moreover, they don't mind singing gospel songs which I translate from Korean Songs. Here is an example of one of the songs we sing, "I don't have any gold and silver but I can give you what I have with the name of J.



J said that the water became the wine, the storm changed to be still and YingDan can see now." Yingdan is one of our children at Dream Home and she is blind. Our caregivers have seen good change in her recently. She is moving around more and is trying to eat by herself. So, the caregivers are happy to sing "J said that YingDan can see now". Our wonderful teacher Li and I tell B stories every day. One day, I told them I want to see them in

heaven. I asked them if they want to see me in heaven. They said "Yes". I was very pleased with their response so I told them, "We can live together in the world but, we cannot live together unless we have the same spirit in heaven." Several caregivers are very interested in knowing about Him. So, I took 4 caregivers to an Easter service and Alice, our Occupational Therapist gave them Easter eggs. This is the beginning of something new in their lives. **Please lift up each of the caregivers in prayer.**

YongEn (Sam) participated in an International chess competition. He was the representative of his school. He won in the HunNan district. He wasn't as successful in the city competition. I am so proud of him. A reporter from the TV station wanted to interview Sam but he didn't want to be

interviewed as he said he didn't want everybody to know that he is an orphan. **Please pray for his confidence in Him.**

ZhiLei, We continue to ask you to pray for his adoption. One family from USA is praying about him and deciding if they would like to adopt Zhilei. I sent them a video showing ZhiLei's movement and his legs X-ray and medical report. If it is God's will, he will find a family if not, our God will provide the best way for him. He is doing so well in the school. Many times he gets 100 score in Math and Chinese. Please continually join us in praying for his adoption.



Elaine, It is not easy for me to come back home from the orphanage each day because Elaine used to welcome me when I came back home. Recently a group of American people were in China and they understood that I missed Elaine. They know what is love, they know it is not easy for people to miss someone. But, I am very grateful that Elaine's recovering is very well. She is doing her best to follow her Doctor's instruction and she is having physical therapy continually. We talk often by phone. March 30th was her 75th birthday. Many friends from China sent an email with greetings for her birthday and a special memory of her. We also saw each other through SKYPE during her birthday party in her church. People from the night market, custodians from our apartment, neighbors and Elaine's friends always ask me when she will be back to China. Everyone misses Elaine, not only me. She is a very special sister and a very lovely person. We will never forget her lovely heart. **Please keep praying for her health. She appreciates everybody's prayers for her.**

I need our Lord every moment, I also need your prayer. I cannot do anything without Him and your prayer. Please, join us to pray for our children. Everyone has noticed a difference since they came to Dream Home. They are healthy by His grace. People can see His miracle through our children. During this season the children can easily become unwell and get a cold or cough. **Please, pray for their health.** I want to be healthy too for His glory. I have been having some headaches since I had my accident in July 2012, this happens especially in winter. **Please pray for my health too.**
