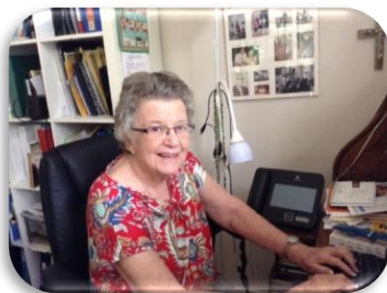
**Do you remember MingGe** who was adopted by John and Danelle in '09?

My friend, Kieth also needs prayers since her Mom recently went to heaven. She has been so wonderful to take care of me in every way while also being with her Mom every day. Please, continue to pray for my complete recovery.

**Now, I would like to share news about our children.** It's very strange to be talking about our children while I am across the ocean, but I'm glad to be sending our News Letter with Elaine.

I want to tell you about Sam(YongEn) who is a boy with spinal bifida who is relying on a

wheelchair. He has been learning to drive a special car for the handicapped since last June. Finally, he got a driver's license in March. I am so proud of him. He still has English class with three Chinese kids every Friday afternoon. **Please, lift his future up continually.** It is not easy for the disabled people to find a job here. Especially, there are many obstacles. Disabled people have a hard time going to work since there are many stairs in the building. I believe that God will have plans to give him hope and a future.
