I am so grateful to have volunteers for many days to clean all the mess. It was impossible to clean and move back to our own building without them.

Finally, after we moved back, our 7 children from another building moved to the children's building while their building is working for the sprinkler. These 7 children are hyperactive and the room is too small to contain them well. I am very glad that it is Summer now so we can take them outside where free to run, ride and play in the paly ground.



It was perfect time when we had a team from Indiana Wesleyan University in the beginning of May. Jill, a friend of Alice who worked with us for 5 years, came to



our Dream Home last year and returned with her nursing students again this year too. They have an exchange students program with the Medical University in ShenYang for 2 weeks in May. They chose one day to be volunteers for children at Dream Home. Each student took one child outside and played with them. They also had a small group activity with kids. It was the children's first activity in the outside this year since the long winter is long and windy here.
